# 11 CANCELLING / POSTPONING SAILING DUE TO WEATHER CONDITIONS

Whanganui Sailing Club

### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this document is to set out the process for deciding when sailing would be cancelled or postponed due to the weather conditions on the day of the event.

#### **SCOPE**

This process relates to the sailing events under the control of a Race Officer. In most cases, the events will be Club races, but may include other regattas.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 1. Race Officer ultimate responsibility for deciding whether to continue, cancel or postpone an event.
- 2. Safety Officer/Sailing Committee support decision-making process with assessments and advice.

#### **PROCESS**

#### **Assess**

Weather conditions assessed through:

- a. Weather forecasts
- b. Observation clubhouse and around sailing area
- c. On-water observation
- d. Discussion with relevant persons.

#### **Decide**

Race Officer makes the decision to continue, cancel or postpone in consultation with Safety Officer and the sailing committee.

#### Communicate

## 1. Continue

Event proceeds as normal <u>but</u> additional safety precautions are implemented, such as extra support boats and crews, more frequent radio communication, advice given to less capable sailors, shortened courses, and so on.

## 2. Cancel or postpone

Communicate as appropriate
